

The Lewisburg Water and Sewer Board held its regular monthly meeting on February 18, 2020. The meeting was held at 100 Water Street, Lewisburg, Tennessee. Board members present were Chairman Bill Marsh, Secretary Joe Harris and Board member Nicholas Tipper. Also present were General Manager Trigg Cathey, Supervisors Terry Smith, Caryl Giles, Roscoe Brannon, Kent Sweeton, Gerald Greggs, Pete Griffin, Administrative Assistant Lisa Parsons and Billing Clerk Lucy Demastus. Visitors in attendance were Bud Richardson, Curtis Johnson, Bobby Wisner and Barry Wisner.

Chairman Bill Marsh called the meeting to order at 12:00 pm.

- Item 1.** Joe Harris made a motion to approve the minutes of the January 21, 2020 meeting. The motion was seconded by Nicholas Tipper. Motion passed. Voice votes – 3 ayes.
- Item 2.** January Bills and Financial Statement – Nicholas Tipper made a motion to approve the January bills and financial statement. Joe Harris seconded the motion. Motion passed. Voice vote – 3 ayes.
- Item 3.** Water – Sewer Request – There were 8 residential water tap requests and 4 requests for residential sewer in the month of January.
- Item 4.** Water Plant- Reports and Memos – Water Plant Supervisor Terry Smith reported on the monthly activities of the plant. The water plant operated at an average of 17.8 hours per day. The three-month water loss average was 25.0%. The plant ran at a capacity of 72.5 % for the month of October.
- Item 5.** Wastewater Plant- Reports and Memos – Wastewater Plant Supervisor Caryl Giles reported on the monthly activities of the wastewater plant.

Wastewater employees hauled 186,082 gallons of sludge from the Cornersville WWTP to be converted into bio-solids.

Wastewater employees hauled 176,700 gallons of mud from the Water Plant.

Wastewater employees hauled 323 tons of bio solids to a local farm.

6a. Project Update

1. Nitrogen and Phosphorous Removal – Wastewater Treatment Plant – Bala from the State Revolving Fund agency came over and did a final walk through. He gave us final approval on the project.
2. Snell Branch Sewer Pumping Station – Richland has had issues installing the new sluice gate. Until it is installed successfully, we will not pay Richland the final \$15,000.
3. Sidewalks on Mooresville Road TDOT project- We have moved all of our water lines so that we are ready for this project and have reported this to Iraj at TDOT.

6b. Curtis Johnson (a resident on Craig Moore road) gave an update of his plans to extend the water main on Craig Moore Road. This project will be a joint effort of the residents and the State of Tennessee.

6c. Bill Marsh made a motion to allow a county resident on Finley Beech road to connect to our sewer system. The motion was seconded by Joe Harris. Motion passed. Voice vote - 3ayes.
