Notes: 1. All containers to be emptied and rinsed. 2. No motor oil, insecticide, herbicide or hazardous chemical containers. 3. Plastic bags should be returned to grocery or department store. 4. No plastic film (no plastic sheets, tarps or wrap). 5. No styrofoam or expanded foam containers no restroom papers, papers that contain synthetic materials, or that are contaminated with food.
